Request for Proposal for Celebrating 250 Years: Pennsylvania & Lawrence County Trivia Challenge

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The New Castle Public Library (NCPL), in partnership with the Lawrence County Historical Society (LCHS), will celebrate Pennsylvania's 250th anniversary with a trivia contest that highlights the rich history and culture of the Commonwealth and Lawrence County. "Celebrating 250 Years: Pennsylvania & Lawrence County Trivia Challenge" is an exciting expansion of Lawrence County Trivia, an initiative of LCHS which has been managed by the NCPL staff for the past two years. Set up for junior and senior high school students, the program faced significant challenges from the disruptions of COVID-19. This is an excellent opportunity to revitalize and expand the program to include Pennsylvania history, reigniting student engagement. The event will bring together history enthusiasts, community members, and trivia lovers to test their knowledge about Pennsylvania's and Lawrence County's founding, significant events, and influential figures. This contest serves as a fun and educational way to reflect on Pennsylvania's journey from its colonial origins to its role in shaping the nation. NCPL is seeking an individual with experience in historical research to review and revise existing trivia questions, as well as research and create new questions.

Purpose: For more than 210 years, the New Castle Public Library has worked to expand and introduce new services that enhance the educational and recreational needs of our residents. SCOPE OF WORK:

- Review existing Lawrence County trivia questions (approximately 850) and assess them for accuracy, clarity, and relevance.
- Ensure that existing trivia questions are equally distributed across six categories (Geography, History, Industry, People, Buildings and Sports), and that the questions possess enduring accuracy, relevance and pertinence.
- Determine which existing questions can be adapted or removed in favor of new questions that specifically address the significance of Lawrence County as it relates to Pennsylvania history as a whole.
- Research and create trivia questions (60) that specifically address the significance of Lawrence County as it relates to Pennsylvania history as a whole, equally distributed across six categories (Geography, History, Industry, People, Buildings and Sports). These questions will be solicited from the public in partnership with the staff at the New Castle Public Library.
- Narrow the number of questions to 600, including the new additions.

DELIVERABLES:

- 540 revised questions pertaining to Lawrence County history.
- 60 new questions addressing the significance of Lawrence County to Pennsylvania history as a whole.

- Estimated costs for all work with fee breakout as allocated to time spent
